Situated in the upper center of this image is the sprawling metropolis of Athens, Greece. Its people invented the word 'metropolis'. Also plumbing. Also streets. The nation of Greece comprises thousands of islands in addition to large sections of mainland, all nestled within the Aegean Sea. That translates to 8,498 miles of coastline, the most of any country in the Mediterranean.
